Eastern Idaho and Virtual Workshops

On March 1, the IGWA hosted a successful Eastern Idaho Workshop on the Idaho State University campus. About 50 drillers attended the Workshop to obtain Continuing Education Credits for their licenses. On March 7, the IGWA hosted the annual Virtual Workshop and had over 50 in attendance. The IGWA will also continue to provide updated education videos and exams as part of its online CEC Program so that folks can continue to receive the Credits needed for relicensing.



Report from IGWA's Executive Director

DOMESTIC WELL EXEMPTION LEGISLATION

During the 2024 Idaho Ground Water Annual Convention we reported that the domestic well exemption Legislation drafted by the Idaho Water Users Association would be a critical issue for our industry. At that point in time the DRAFT would have required that any subdivision with less than 5-acre lots would have needed to have a water right approved and a community or shared well developed. IGWA was part of some discussions in 2023 but did not agree with the final DRAFT that was presented to the IGWA Board on January 25 by the Idaho Water Users Association's Executive Director. Following our Convention and the meeting with the IWUA Executive Director on January 25, the Legislative DRAFT changed to only requiring a shared or community well in subdivisions with more than 10 lots that are 5 or less acres in size only in areas where people do not receive irrigation water from an irrigation district, canal, or ditch company. An e-mail was sent out to



the IGWA membership with this information. This past week I was notified that the Legislation (Senate Bill 1370) would not be moving forward this Session. 2024 will provide another opportunity for the IGWA and the water user community to continue to meet on this issue and discuss a common-sense solution that doesn't impact the drilling industry.

- 3. **School Involvement:** This might include school clubs, offices held, sports, expressive arts (music, drama, ect.) and committees.

- 5. Volunteer Involvement: List any volunteer activities, what you did and how much time you spent volunteering.
- 6. **Work Experience:** If you worked please let us know where you worked and for how long. Include practical work and family business experience.
- 7. Honors, Awards and Recognition: Tell us about any academic, music, service or other awards.
- 8. Three Letters of Recommendation: At least one must be from someone other than a teacher.

Report from IGWA's Executive Director

ELECTRICAL EXAM & LOW TEMPERATURE GEOTHERMAL RULEMAKING

The IGWA has been working with the Idaho Division of Professional Licensing and the Electrical Board to initiate Negotiated Rulemaking following adjournment of the 2024 Idaho Legislative Session regarding the electrical exam and the issues our industry has with passing this exam. Once we get some dates scheduled, we will send out an invitation asking you to join our discussions so that we can draft the language needed to address the concerns we have heard. There may be a possibility that our industry could have its own electrical exam specifically for domestic pump installation. We are also soon expecting to see a DRAFT from the Idaho Department of Water Resources regarding the Low Temperature Geothermal Rules. In April we will be invited to participate in Negoti-



ated Rulemaking with the Department to address the concerns the industry has with the current 85-degree Low Temperature Geothermal Temperature Rule. Over the past couple of years, the IGWA has voiced concerns regarding the 85-degree rule to the Department of Water Resources. We are hopeful that this Negotiated Rulemaking process this spring will result in a higher temperature that will resolve the issues for the industry.
